Targeted Rates	At present 2009		Under the Proposed Multi-Bin Collection System 2012
- Per Household from:	\$100	→	\$430
- Will increase from:	\$1,521,451	→	\$6,985,355
- Cost to the district:	\$2,046,801	→	\$5,412,421

Is this a good idea? We don't think so:

- X The cost in targeted rates will increase x 4.
- X The cost of Council charges and tip fees will increase x 2.2 or more.
- X There will be no savings for those who put out less waste – no incentive to reduce waste.
- X You will lose your freedom to choose from any of the local waste operators for general waste and you will be committed to covering the cost of Council's waste operator.
